PRECIOUS BLOOD OF THE LORD: Because of the seriousness of this flu season, Bishop Bartchak has asked that the Precious Blood of the Lord not be offered at Mass temporarily. It is the belief of the Catholic Church that the whole Body of Christ is present under either form of consecrated bread and wine. Also, the exchange of the sign of peace should avoid bodily contact. A reverent nod with eye contact and a smile will be the temporary practice. Reception of Holy Communion on the hand is encouraged; however, reception on the tongue may not be denied. These norms are in effect throughout the winter months or until the flu season is over.

NEEDED - PARISHIONERS to volunteer to be trained for various ministries in our Parish. We are particularly in need of Readers for all Masses, especially the 10:30 AM. Additional Ushers are also needed for the 10:30 AM Mass. Eucharistic Ministers are needed for the 4:00 PM Mass and 10:30 AM Mass. Altar Servers are needed for the 4:00 PM Mass and 8:00 AM Mass. SACRED RELICS OF THE SAINTS: TREASURES OF THE CHURCH: Christ the King Parish in Houtzdale presents a teaching and exposition of Sacred Relics on Monday February 25 at 6:00 pm. Father Carlos Martins of the Companions of the Cross will be here with a very special Vatican collection of over 150 relics, some as old as 2000 years. Among the treasures will be relics of St. Maria Goretti, St. Therese of Lisieux (the "Little Flower"), St. Francis of Assisi, St. Anthony of Padua, St. Thomas Aquinas, and St. Faustina Kowalska. In addition, there will also be present a portion of the veil of Our Lady, as well as one of the largest remaining pieces of the True Cross in the world. Those in attendance will be able to examine and venerate each relic. In the Church's history many miracles and healings have been worked in the presence of relics, and many have been healed through this ministry. Please do not miss this opportunity. You are encouraged to bring your articles of devotion (such as rosaries, holy cards, etc.) and pictures of ill friends/family members which you will be able to touch to the reliquaries as a means of intercession.
